Settings

Genre:

Controlling Idea:

Protagonist:

After graduate, they split apart and lost contact. Now Philip was under serious financial issue that involved with his family, and he had tried borrow money everywhere. He is in fact a naive person, too honest that always been used.

(Stands for Altruism)

Motivation: He needed the money to cover the crisis, so that his family will be maintained. On the other hand, he wanted to reconcile with his old friend Andrew.

Appearance: Tall and thin. Golden curved hair. Wearing in black suit with blue bow tie. However, the size of the suit doesn't fit much on him. Some freckles on his face, and his beard is uncleaned. Dark under-eye circles made him looks exhausted.

Antagonist:

Gina, wife of Andrew. Housewife with no job. Used to be friends with both Philip and Andrew in

high school period. Unsatisfied with the marriage since Andrew was busying on his business and no longer spend much time with her like before. Also, they don't have any child after so many years of marriage. Gina had grown with a suspicion that Andrew had someone outside(in fact he did not cheat). However, she does not want a divorce since Andrew is so successful in business. On the other hand, Gina used to like Philip in high school but missed the chance due to Andrew's trick(more details on Background story).

(Stands for Selfishness)

Motivation: On this party, she wanted to meet Philip again, and wanted to cheat with him as a counter to Andrew.

Appearance: Gorgeous lady, with blonde curly hair. Medium height but very slim. Black dress with some fancy lace and ribbons. High heels on her feet. Heavy makeup. A shiny ruby necklace on her neck.

● Side Avatar:

Andrew, a successful business man. Well known to his altruism since he was always doing donations and initiated a charitable foundation. However, he is in fact selfish and vain. He will always fulfill his own goal at any cost.

(Stands for Selfishness)

Motivation: He participated the party to flaunt his success. All he wanted was the respect. He had to maintain his character of wealthy and generous, so that he will gain fame and be popular at the lowest cost.

Appearance: Medium height with big belly. Short brown hair. Luxury dark blue suit with stripes, white shirt and neat tie. Round frame glasses and shiny leather shoes. Golden Rolex on his left wrist.

Background story:

Nine years ago, Andrew used the friendship with Philip for his own goodness in love. When Philip and Andrew were in high school, both of them fell in love with Gina, one of their mutual friends. They didn't know the other's feeling till one day Andrew mentioned his plan of inviting Gina for a date to Philip. • inciting incident:

Complication:

At first, Philip thought Andrew did not recognize him, so he went to Andrew again with a self-introduction. Philip had to decide again:

A2 Accept Gina's money ---> Climax Two (being selfish, moral bankrupt)

B2 Refuse Gina's money ---> Climax Three (being altruistic, stay with good morality)

Climax:

One

Andrew accepted Gina. He can no longer resist his impulse of having the relation of love with Gina. Gina was happy to see this as well. The two of them moved to a private place away the party secretly. Philip will get the financial aid from Gina easily since they were in a cheated love.

Two

Three

Resolution:

One
